

Wisconsin Prevention Awards 2008 Nominations

The Wisconsin Prevention Awards recognize individuals and groups who make significant contributions in the field of alcohol and other drug abuse, positive youth development, or have improved the overall health of the community.

The Award Categories are:

Leadership in Prevention. To recognize an individual who has made an outstanding contribution to the field at the community, state, or national level through professional service that benefited Wisconsin prevention efforts.

Outstanding Prevention Volunteer – Adult. To recognize an adult volunteer who has made significant contributions to their community in alcohol and other drug abuse prevention, positive youth development or the overall health of the community. This award recognizes service outside of employment, but may be given to someone who works in the prevention field in recognition of their contributions as a volunteer in community prevention initiatives.

Outstanding Prevention Volunteer – Youth. To recognize a youth (under age 21) volunteer, who has made significant contributions to their community or has shown leadership in their community's overall prevention efforts.

Outstanding Prevention Coalition. To recognize a coalition or community partnership that has made significant contributions to their community in substance abuse prevention, positive youth development or the overall health of the community.

Lifetime Achievement in Prevention. To recognize an individual that has made exceptional contributions to the field over a number of years. This individual is an innovative thinker, whose work has advanced prevention efforts in Wisconsin and is viewed by his or her peers as an integral part of Wisconsin prevention efforts.
